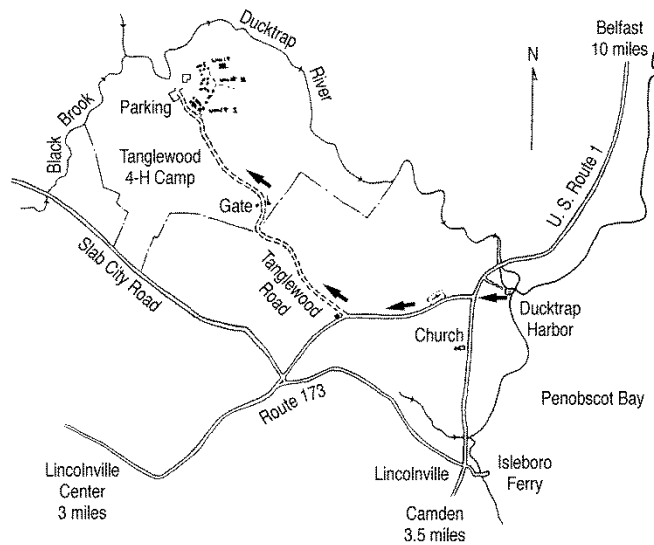
Cellphone coverage is spotty at the camp and we prefer you leave yours turned off. Tell your loved ones that the camp phone 207-789-5868 can be called during the day.

Directions to Tanglewood 4-H Camp, Lincolville Beach, Maine

From the north: take Route 1 south from Belfast –10 miles. Just after crossing the Duck Trap River, look for the Maine Coast Men sign and turn right.

From the south: take Route 1 north from Camden through Lincolville Beach and then turn left at the Maine Coast Men sign.

After turning off Route 1, you make another right turn after 1/3-mile (at another Maine Coast Men sign). Continue on the unpaved road into camp, about 3/4 mile.
